Spotlight on Environmental Science

The third grade students in Mrs. Hoppe's & Mrs. Selk's room are studying weather. As part of this weather unit, (an ongoing eSTEM project) students learned about the components of weather and the measurement of humidity and what it means. They created hygrometers using pinecones and pins (pine cones release seeds based on humidity) to be able to measure humidity. The students then placed the hygrometers outside overnight. In the morning students found the exact humidity level. Students then made a set of instructions of how to use the hygrometer at home.
